## **OUR AUCTION**

### **GOLD COAST AUCTION NEWS:**

Hopefully, you know we are holding our club's **Auction Saturday, April 10th**. And most importantly, I hope the doors will be open early (at 8:00 a.m.) so we can get in and set up without any craziness and even allow us a few moments to think.

If you are helping me during the Auction, please be on time. I need as many hands as possible to **QUICKLY** set up every table for the Silent Auction area, the Cashier space, the Auctioneer, and the Registration Desk.

Remember, sellers do **NOT** get tables. Everything you are placing up for auction has to sit on the floor. So please bring a tarp, sheet, plastic, etc. to protect the carpet, and make certain your containers are clean and do not have ants, etc. walking or crawling about.

Make certain **ALL** your items are tagged as per the **direction sheet** you received prior to the auction. Don't forget to place your designated **LETTER** on all the **tags** that must be securely attached to your merchandise **as well as** on the **Cashier sheet** that you hand over to our cashiers **PRIOR** to the auction beginning. Be certain to cut the single tag sheet into 3 parts, punch a hole through all three

pieces, then securely fasten them to your merchandise with wire or string. Merchandise missing or with incorrect tags will not be auctioned. It is **not** the Auctioneer's job, the cashiers, the holding area person, or me, to figure out what you were thinking.

Also, **no opening bid** will be less than \$5.00. So, if you wish to open with a minimum bid and leave the bidding to the skill of our auctioneer (and he is good,) you must place an opening bid of at least \$5.00 in the space provided. Of course, if you wish to begin higher, do so.

Most importantly, I need **everyone** to bring at least **one piece of merchandise** for the Silent Auction area. I realize that (hopefully) people have been donating items to Ed for our portion of the BSF convention. But our club's smaller silent auction also needs goods that can be either bonsai or garden related. We get 100% of the monies collected. So, please make every effort to bring at least one item and drop that merchandise off at the Silent Auction Area.

Randy will be our auctioneer that day. Please spread the word about our auction. Hopefully, the newspapers will place our blurb in their garden sections. With papers going out of business or downsizing to little more than flyers, we need all the help we can get.
